Kingstec Campus Learning Centre and the Aldershot Afterschool Association are driven by the core purpose of providing high quality, inclusive and affordable child care services for families attending NSCC and living in our community. Kingstec has had a child care centre in operation since 1978 as part of the training program for the Early Childhood Studies Program. Both programs provide opportunities as lab school learning environments for NSCC Kingstec students pursuing their Early Childhood Education diploma.

The Kingstec Campus Learning Centre and Aldershot Afterschool Association is looking for individuals who take our core purpose to heart!
